

## Be-on-road's file format for import of favorites

### Specification:

Points of interest for import are stored in special file. This file has the following properties:

- it is a **tab-separated values (TSV) file**
- the separator in file is **TAB**
- text is in **UTF-8 encoding**

Information for import must have the following structure:

- NAME
- ADDRESS
- PHONE NUMBER
- E-MAIL ADDRESS
- WEB ADDRESS
- LONGITUDE           WGS84 in decimal format
- LATITUDE            WGS84 in decimal format
- COMMENTS

If you don't want to fill some value, you can skip it by pressing the TAB key.

It is common that every category of POI has own icon. Icon can be saved either in Bitmap Image File (BMP) or in Portable Network Graphics (PNG). Transparency is allowed in PNG format. **Icon filename must be the same with the TSV filename** (for example aponia.tsv and aponia.bmp/aponia.png).

### Example (content of aponia.tsv):

*Note:*

*'\t' denotes TAB key*

*'\n' denotes new line in file*

### Comment to the example:

First line is the header of the TSV file (still the same).

Second line represents information with filled all data.

Third line represents information with partly filled data.
